APPROPRIATE TOPS

- **Polo shirts** (any style or design – students are not limited to solid colors or logo size)
- **Spirit shirts** (any CCI or CCHS shirt that is affiliated with our schools, groups, clubs, sports, or activities)
- **College shirts** (any shirt that honors the pursuit of higher education and promotes a college-bound culture)

APPROPRIATE BOTTOMS

- All clothing from the waist down must be in a solid color. The choices include blue, black, khaki, or gray.
- Shorts, skirts, skorts, and solid color jumpers can be worn. The hemline must be mid-thigh or longer.
- Pants and blue jeans may be worn. Denim shorts and skirts that meet the criteria above may be worn.

APPROPRIATE FOOTWEAR

- All shoes must have a back or heel strap. Shoes with lacing holes must have the laces included and tied.
- Heels may not be higher than 2”.
- Flip flops, house slippers, athletic sandals, rubber sandals, shower shoes, and Heelies are not allowed.

APPROPRIATE OUTERWEAR

- Winter coats and bulky jackets must be stored in the lockers before first period.
- Sweatshirts and hoodies can be worn during the school day over any of the acceptable shirts listed above.

APPROPRIATE HAIR, JEWELRY, and ACCESSORIES

- The only pierced jewelry that can be worn is in the ears.
- Jewelry, collars, bracelets, wrist bands, and all other accessories must be appropriate. Leather, spiked, and sharp edges are prohibited. Inappropriate language, symbols, and graphics are not allowed.
- Hats, head covering, and head gear must be stored in the locker, unless related to religious beliefs.
- Boys are not allowed to wear head bands, hair bows, barrettes, or ponytails.
- Unnatural hair color and/or distracting hairstyles that disrupt the learning environment are not permitted.
- Sunglasses cannot be worn inside the school.

APPROPRIATE BACKPACKS and LOCKER USAGE

- Lockers are assigned to individual students and cannot be shared. Combinations should not be divulged.
- Students may access their lockers before first period, between all classes, and after school.
- Students are allowed to wear or carry string backpacks during the school day.
- Due to the classroom size, any backpack that is not a string backpack must be kept in the locker. This includes rolling backpacks, satchels, and any other oversized storage bag.

APPROPRIATE CLOTHING

Garments must be in good condition, have no holes or fraying, be hemmed, and may not drag on the ground. Pants, shorts, and skirts must be worn properly at the waist.

INAPPROPRIATE CLOTHING

Garments that cannot be worn at school include: cut-off shorts, halters, sleeveless shirts, strapless tops, spaghetti straps, open underarm shirts, tank tops, and clothing that exposes the underarms, shoulders, midriff, or cleavage. Additional items that are prohibited include: undershirts, pajamas, sweat pants, boxer shorts, athletic shorts, athletic sweat suits, overalls, jogging pants, sweat pants, stretch pants, yoga pants, and leggings. Fabric that cannot be worn includes leather, suede, and vinyl.

DRESS CODE ENFORCEMENT

At Clear Creek Intermediate, we recognize that a student's personal style is an expression of individualism. Being well-dressed and well-groomed for school is an outward sign of politeness. We encourage our students to utilize the parameters of the CCI Dress Code to show their respect for the high-quality education they are receiving.

Any clothing, accessory, hair color, or hairstyle that is deemed inappropriate will result in the student being required to change or adjust prior to attending classes. Repeated failure to comply with the Clear Creek Intermediate Dress Code will result in disciplinary action.
